Ocean acidification at UN Ocean Conference 2022

NZOAC and PI-TOA members returning from UNOC 2022 report that this conference made it clear that the ocean is on the political agenda, ECOP voices are being heard, and SIDS and other developing countries are leading by doing.

- Speaking on behalf of PSIDS at the <u>Interactive Dialogue on Minimising and addressing ocean</u> acidification, deoxygenation and ocean warming, Hon. John M. Silk of the Republic of the Marshall Islands <u>stressed the vulnerability of SIDS to ocean acidification</u>.
- PI-TOA and PCCOS participated as panellists in three events, including the official side-event
 <u>Taking action to address ocean acidification & implement SDG 14.3</u>. Dr. Katy Soapi,
 Coordinator at PCCOS and current chair of the PI-TOA, stressed the importance of trust in
 partnerships: "Building long-term relationships is the single most important aspect for
 getting things done. Progress happens at the speed of trust, and this must underpin our
 work on OA regionally."
